***The Patriarchs* by Beth Moore**

"The Patriarchs" is a ten-lesson study, each lesson covering five days. The focus is on encountering God in the lives of the patriarchs of Genesis: Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Like Martha, we love Jesus and really want to serve him . . . yet we struggle with weariness, resentment, and feeling of inadequacy. With her fresh approach to the familiar Bible story, Joanna Weaver, the author, shows how all of us--Marys and Marthas alike--can deepen our devotion, strengthen our service, and do both with less stress and greater joy.
